BREAKFAST RE LAUNCH

We set a new target date of Oct. 12, and will evaluate the situation and provide another update in late Sept.

Changes coming with relaunch:

- masks will be mandatory for all volunteers and staff
- \bullet guests will be asked to hand sanitize upon entering
- guest seating capacity will be reduced and controlled for better spacing and less crowding
- clear plastic screens where possible to provide separation between servers and guests
- beverage kitchen and counter to reduce congestion and provide separation between server and guests
